Methodology

CBC Calgary: Referendum Poll 2026

- Conducted by live interviewers, located in Alberta
- Random sample, including 30% landlines and 70% cell phones
- Option of answering over the telephone or online
- Numbers called up to 5 times, at 5 different times of day
- Quotas set to ensure representativeness
- The response rate among valid numbers was 11.2 per cent.
- n = 1200, +/-2.8%, 19 times in 20
- **Survey dates were September 8 to 21, 2026**
- Previous surveys conducted in March 2018, March 2020, May 2020, April 2021, October 2022, April 2023* (Calgary only), May 2024, May 2025, and April 2026.
