Data Collection

- 900 interviews with Albertans aged 18 and over
- April 29 to May 8, 2025
- Hybrid methodology
 - Randomly recruited by telephone
 - Respondents were given the option of answering the survey over the telephone or online
- Results weighted by region according to Statistics Canada proportions
- Quotas set to ensure representativeness in terms of age and gender at both a provincial and regional level
